Permission has been granted by the Teacup Dogs Agility Association for the holding of this event under Teacup Dog Agility Association Rules and Regulations.

TRIAL INFORMATION

This trial will be held outdoors on dirt under cover with containment fencing. On both days, site will be **open at 7:45** for set up. Measurements start at 8:00. Obstacle familiarization: 8:30. **Seminar starts at 9:00 on Saturday**. On Sunday, General and Game Briefing at 8:45. **First dog on the line at 9:00**.

The following is a list of obstacles to be used. Contacts have rubber surface.

A-frame (6' 8" slatless), Tire Jump (16"), Dog walk (8' slatless ramps), Table (36" by 36"), Open (Pipe) Tunnel (16"), Single & winged jumps (30" bar), Teeter (8' slatless, 12" wide), Weave poles (24" centers).

A warm up area with jump provided for all exhibitors. Obstacle familiarization available in the morning prior to judging.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. Fast track dogs will only get Qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels. New Title Rosettes awarded.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AT THE SHOW SITE AND HOTELS

All dogs must be kept on leash except in designated areas.

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs 20" and under and 12 months and older, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium; you can also register at the trial or online. Registration fee of \$12 is in addition to trial fees. TDAA rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com.

GAMES DESCRIPTIONS

Full House

Full House is a game of timing in which the dog is obligated to collect the elements of the full house, earn as many other points as possible, and end time without losing points on a time penalty. Scored Points, Less Penalty, then Time.

Heinz 57

Heinz 57 is a dog's choice game. Collect exactly 57 points. Obstacles on course have varying point values, and one obstacle can actually double your points. Scored Points, then Time.

Colors

Colors is a sequencing game. The handler has a choice of running any one of three short courses that are woven together on the field. Scored Faults, then Time.

Dare to Double

Dare to Double is a dog's-choice game. The objective is to score as many points as possible, repeating a doubling obstacle on course as often as time allows. The dog risks losing half his points if the doubling obstacle is faulted! The dog must also get to the finish line before course time elapses or lose half his points. Dare to Double is scored Points, Then Time.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Agility Class

- Beginner** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Intermediate Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Superior Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Classes

- Games I** All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games II Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.
Games III Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – Games & Standard Classes

TDAA offers FEO runs, open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring. FEO can also be used to rerun a course for additional practice or trying a different strategy.

Fast Track Move-Ups: Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day if the dog qualifies first in Beginner and again in Intermediate. Likewise, a dog may move up from Games I to Games III by qualifying at each of the lower two levels. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog. **Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with this FAST TRACK Move-Up Request form. Payment of the \$8.00 is not a guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level and is non-refundable. This fee must be paid for this trial even if a Fast Track fee has been paid in the past.**

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Each handler may select the jump height they wish their dog to jump. Dogs will continue to be scored with dogs at their measured height. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division but will be scored in that higher height division. A judge must measure all dogs with a pending registration.

- 2" jump height for dogs measuring 4" or less at the withers
- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 16" or less at the withers
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 20" or less at the withers.
- Veteran Dogs (7 yrs and older) receive an extension of standard course time based on measured height.
 - Measured height of 2" & 4" dogs receive an additional 4 seconds
 - Measured heights of 8", 12" & 16" dogs receive an additional 2 seconds
- Disabled Handlers receive an extension of 4 seconds to standard course times and qualifying course times for games. The proof of the disability shall be the handler's disability parking tag or other documentation.
- There will be no special system of titling for disabled handlers or veteran dogs.

Please consult your jump height card/email to confirm the correct measured height to enter. If you do not have a TDAA height card/email, your dog must be measured at this trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- * The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the warm-up area. It is expressly understood the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. * In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- * Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- * Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- * Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- * At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- * Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.
- * Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry Forms, one dog per entry form.
- * **Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement are NOT acceptable.** Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Credit card entries with an emailed entry form and signed TDAA agreement are accepted.
- * The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. Full refund (less transaction fee if entered with credit card) for bitches in heat if notification is sent to the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail OK) no later than May 7, 20158
